Unstyled Antique Tractor Pulling Contest

Weight Classes:

3,500 - 4,500 - 5,500 - 6,500 - 7,500 - 8,500 - 9,500

Tractors that can not meet the following rules, may pull in the Open
Antique classes.

**Announcements made the day of the pull will take precedence over
written rules.**

1. Tractor and engine MUST be from the same manufacturer.
2. No turbo chargers permitted. Fire extinguisher is recommended.
3. Tractor must be equipped with stock pumps only.
4. Must have working PTO.
5. Must pull from stock draw bar.
6. Only manufacturers stock side curtains are permitted.
7. Maximum tire size is 15.5 x 38. No cut tires.
8. Steel wheels are permitted. No tire chains permitted. No dual wheels permitted.
9. No four wheel drive tractors allowed.
10. Weight includes driver. No weight or driver changes after weigh-in.
11. All weight must be securely fastened. Losing any weights while pulling will result in disqualification.
12. Draw bar height maximum of 18" from ground in ALL classes.
13. Draw bar may NOT be less than 18" from center of axle, not more than 1" in thickness and must have a 3" diameter opening. Pulling point may not be more than 1 1/2" from back edge of hitching device.
14. No tampering of hydraulic control of draw bar while pulling.
15. All minors must have written consent of parent or guardian to enter contest.
16. Judges have the right to stop contestant's tractor if the tractor is being operated in an unsafe manner
17. Tractors may be rechecked after pull is made if there is any question of rule violation.
18. Operators must remain seated during the pull, and must have complete control of the tractor at all times.
19. Only Two adults (1 driver, 1 helper) allowed in pits with each tractor

entered. No exceptions.

20. Tractor may pull in two weight classes, but only once in each class.
21. Contest winners are decided by the total distance pulled.
22. Trophies will be given to the winner of each class.
23. Low gear pull. No mile per hour.
