written rules.**

CLASS A: Performance Gas 4x4 pick-ups: This class is intended for trucks with light modifications only. Any borderline considerations will result in disqualifications or reclassifications.

- Must have current license plate and inspection sticker.
- Light engine/drive line modifications only.
- Single carburetor only or fuel injection.
- No hanging weights.
- No electric drives. All engine accessories belt driven.
- Open headers allowed. No turn outs or verticals.
- Electric fuel pumps allowed.
- No aftermarket rears or axles.
- Max weights 6,600lbs.
- Light suspension modifications only.
- All weights must be secured in bed.
- Springs must be functional with bolt in suspension blocks.
- Clearance required on block.
- No traction bars.
- Gasoline only. No oxygen accelerators.
- No hood or body modifications. Body must be steel. Factory dash and seats.

- Truck must be driven in.
- No alcohol or nitrous systems.
- Hitch height 26"
- Front bumpers must be unaltered if factory stock
- Trucks must be in stock appearance.
- Bed must have metal floor.
- Wooden flatbeds are allowed.

CLASS B: Open Gas 4x4 pick-ups: This class is intended for vehicles with moderate to extreme modifications.

- No limit to engine/drive line modifications. Must meet safety standards.
- Added weight permitted. Must not exceed 7,200lbs.
- If you tow it or haul it in, you run in Class B.
- body and suspension modifications permitted.
- No chains or studded tires.
- Fuel tanks/cells must be in an open area, not in engine compartment or in cab unless original.
- No portion of undercarriage should be visible from above bed.
- Gasoline only. No alcohol or nitrous systems.
- Hitch height 26".
- Hook point must be past rear of truck bed.
- Fire suit, kill switch and fire extinguisher recommended.
- Must wear helmets.
