**Announcements made the day of the pull will take
precedence over written rules.**

Class A: Street Stock Gas 4X4 - This is a stock class. If you intend to pull in this class your truck should not look like a truck set up to pull transfer sleds. We are looking for factory appearing trucks.

1. Driver will provide current drivers license, plate, insurance and registration.
2. No engines, body, drive train or suspension modifications.
3. The following are **NOT** permitted in this class:
 - A. Aftermarket or OEM performance modifications.
 - B. Traction bars
 - C. Bump stops
 - D. Pulling Bumpers
 - E. Weight brackets
 - F. Aftermarket gauges
 - G. Body modifications
4. Max weight 6,450lbs
5. 26" hitch height
6. Truck must be driven in
7. Gasoline only
8. Reese type hitches
9. Must provide your own clevis, 3 3/4" minimum opening.
10. No hanging weights

Class B: Street Stock Diesels 4X4 - This is a stock class. If you intend to pull in this class your truck should not look like a truck set up to pull transfer sleds. We are looking for factory appearing trucks.

1. Driver will provide current drivers license, plate, insurance and registration.
2. No engines, body, drive train or suspension modifications.
3. The following are NOT permitted in this class:
 - A. Aftermarket or OEM performance modifications
 - B. Traction bars
 - C. Bump stops
 - D. Pulling bumpers

- E. Weight brackets
 - F. Aftermarket gauges
 - G. Body modifications
 - H. Performance adding modules/programmers***(see below)
4. Class weight 8,000lb max
 5. 26" hitch height
 6. Trucks must be drive in
 7. Diesel fuel only
 8. Reese type hitches
 9. Must provide your own clevis, 3 3/4" minimum opening.
 10. No hanging weights

***This class will be monitored for excessive black smoke and RPM. The exhaust should be as clean as the factory intended. The presence of unburned fuel is a sign of engine modifications. Do not be surprised if you place in the money, and are disqualified for excessive smoke.
