ALLIS CHALMERS - 160, 170, 180, 190, and newer. CASE - 430, 530, 630, 730, 830, 930, 1030, and newer CASE-IH - All models FORD - 1000 and newer INTERNATIONAL - 706, 806, and newer JOHN DEERE - No two cylinder models MASSEY FERGUSON - 100, 130, 135, 150, and newer MINNEAPOLIS-MOLINE - G705, G707, G708, and newer OLIVER - 1600, 1800, 1900, and newer WHITE - All models

6,500 - 6,500 Turbo - 7,500 - 7,500 Turbo - 9,500 - 11,500 - 13,500 - 15,500 Tractors that cannot meet the following rules, may pull in the open classes.

Announcements made the day of the pull will take precedence over written rules.

- Judges decision is final in all cases. Any argument will result in disqualification and immediate ejection from the premises!
- All tractors that have a high idle speed <u>equal to or less than</u> published in the A&W Dino Test Book, The Nebraska Tractor Test PTO Data, will pull in this class.
- Tractor and engine must both be from the same manufacturer.
- If a turbo has been added to a non-turbo tractor, they must pull in the open class.
- Helmet, fire jacket and leather shoes are recommended in the 11,500 and up classes.
- Must have working PTO.
- Must pull from stock draw bar. Wheelie bars permitted.
- No full cut pulling tires permitted.
- Stock and top cut tires permitted.
- No four wheel drive tractors allowed.
- Weight includes driver. No weight or driver changes after weigh-in.
- Draw bar height maximum 18" from ground in 6,500 6,500 turbo 7,500 7,500 turbo classes.
- Draw bar height maximum 20" from ground in 9,500 11,500 13,500 15,500 classes.

- Draw bar may not be less than 18" from center of axle, not more than 1" in thickness and must have a 3" diameter opening. Pulling point may not be more than 1 ½" from back edge of hitching device.
- No tampering of hydraulic control of draw bar while pulling
- Rubber tires only, no tire chains, or dual wheels permitted.
- Committee has the right to accept or reject all entries.
- Judges have the right to stop contestant's tractor if the tractor is being operated in an unsafe manner.
- All minors must have written consent of parents or guardian to enter contest.
- A member of the committee prior to making pull will check draw bar height.
- Tractors may be rechecked after pull is made if there is any question of rule violation.
- Contest winners to be decided by total distance pulled.
- Tractors will be weighed prior to making pull and after pulling on portable scales on the ground.
- All weight must be securely fastened. Losing any weights while pulling results in disqualification.
- Operators must remain seated during the pull, and must have complete control of tractor at all times
- Only two adults (1 driver, 1 helper) allowed in pits with each tractor entered. No exceptions.
- Tractors may pull in two weight classes, but only once in each class.
- Tractors may only pull in Antique division or Farm division, not both
- Trophies will be given to the winner of each class.
- Premiums: 1st- \$75.00 2nd- \$60.00 3rd- \$45.00 4th- \$30.00 5th- \$15.00
